

**CONFEDERATION OF EUROPEAN

CONTEST RULES**

1. The contest is open to any person 18 years of age or older.
  
2. To enter, send your name, e-mail, and telephone number and submit your logo as a pdf document to [office@baseballeurope.com](mailto:office@baseballeurope.com). Entries should be submitted not later than October 31, 2010. Receipt of submitted entries will not be acknowledged by CEB. The logo should be easy to read and identify, should be recognizable with the CEB logo, and should show the year of the competition, as it is intended that this should be a permanent logo and only the year will change.
  
3. One or more entries per person is accepted.
  
4. Entrants represent and warrant that their submission(s) is/are their original work, has not been copied from others, and does not violate the intellectual property rights of any other person or entity.
  
5. All entry materials become the exclusive property of CEB and will not be returned. Any and all intellectual property rights in and ownership of the winning submission will be deemed transferred, without any compensation or consideration (other than as specified in Paragraph 8 below), to CEB not later than the date of the official announcement of the winner. If considered necessary by CEB, the winner will be required, and undertakes by virtue of his/her submission, to sign an affidavit of eligibility and transfer to CEB of the intellectual property rights and ownership to the winning logo entry.
  
6. CEB, and/or all others authorized by CEB, shall have the right to edit, adapt, and modify the winning submission and to use the winning submission in whatever manner CEB deems appropriate.

7. All submissions will be evaluated by the CEB Marketing Commission and Executive Committee, and the winner selected by the Executive Committee in its sole discretion. The winner will be announced on the CEB website not later than December 20, 2010. All decisions by the CEB Executive Committee are final and binding.

8. The winner of the Contest will receive a cash prize of Euro 1000. Income and other taxes, if any, are the sole responsibility of the winner.

9. CEB is not responsible for late, lost, stolen, misdirected, damaged, incomplete, or illegible entries; or entries that are lost due to computer, internet, or electronic malfunction. CEB reserves the right to cancel or modify the Contest and award the prize by alternate means/method, if fraud or technical failure is determined by CEB, in its sole discretion, to have compromised the integrity of the Contest,. CEB likewise reserves the right to refrain and decline declaring a winner of the contest.

10. Entrants agree that CEB, its promotion partners, related companies, agencies, and their respective employees or officers shall not be liable for injury, losses, damages, or costs of any kind resulting from participation in this Contest or acceptance of or use or misuse of a prize or parts thereof. By entering, participants agree, and are deemed, to be bound by these Contest Rules. In the event of a dispute regarding the identity of the person submitting an electronic entry, the entry will be deemed to be submitted by the person in whose name the e-mail account is registered.

11. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this contest which cannot be amicably resolved between the parties, shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the UNCITRAL Arbitration Rules as at present in force. The number of arbitrators shall be one, to be agreed between the parties. If the parties are unable to agree on the arbitrator, the arbitrator shall be appointed, upon request of one of the parties by the appointing authority, which shall be the German Institute of Arbitration (DIS) Bonn, Germany. The place of arbitration shall be Frankfurt, Germany and the language to be used in the arbitral proceedings shall be English. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final.
