Dear CEB Member Federation:

On behalf of the CEB Executive Committee, I wish to advise you that the annual **CEB Congress** is to be held in Rotterdam, Holland on **March 17, 2012**, celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of the Dutch baseball federation. Amongst other matters, the delegates will be called upon to approve **modifications of the CEB Statutes** proposed by the Executive Committee. A copy of the proposed modification will be forwarded to you for your consideration.

**Incentive Payment:** The CEB Executive Committee decided at its last meeting that, in the interest of cost savings, the incentive grant of 400 Euros per Federation (provided at prior Congresses) will no longer be given.

**Proposed Agenda Items:** You are advised that, should you have an item for the Congress to consider which you desire to have placed on the Agenda, you are kindly requested to make a written request for such consideration by not later than December 17, 2011. **Voting right and outstanding debts to CEB:** You are reminded of the fact that entitlement to vote at the Congress (including Statute modifications) is conditioned upon the Delegate's federation having paid the 2012 annual membership fee as well as all other outstanding amounts, including subscription fees and penalties, not later than 11:00pm of the night prior to commencement of the 2012 Congress.

**Hotel and Visa Requirements:** Information regarding registration for hotel accommodations in Rotterdam will be available in due time on the CEB Website. In addition, your attention is brought to the fact that your delegates may be required to obtain a Dutch visa in order to attend the Congress. You should promptly contact the nearest Dutch Embassy/ Consulate to make arrangements for the visa, if needed.
